Plants

- Installation of 40 - 5 gallon shrubs to be only native to Colorado

- Installation of 80 - 1 gallon perennials to be only native to Colorado

Rock

- Installation of 20.50 tons of 1-1/2" local river rock to replace areas where junipers are removed.

- Installation of 1800 square feet of landscape fabric to replace areas where junipers are removed.

Irrigation

All irrigation will be done on a time and material basis with a do not exceed of \$2,500

-Juniper removal will be done using various equipment due to root depth potentially running underneath sidewalks. All Terrain will dig out the junipers from all areas, amend the soil, establish positive drainage, install new fabric to removed areas, and install rock to the same areas. 12 Colorado native plants will be installed around each building to establish a healthy native environment to surrounding insects and species.

-Maintenance over the first year of the plants will consist of no pruning, increased water from the drip line for the first 3 weeks for establishment then standard watering expectations dependent upon the season.
